HOW DOES MY HOPE BAG SERVE?

- In-home visit with bag recipient and learn of her needs and desires
- Assistance with scheduling rides to treatments
- Referrals to resources including house cleaning, prosthetics, financial assistance, etc.
- Encouragement, emotional support, and comfort
- Wellness education
- Benevolence assistance: Gas, Groceries, Medical co-pays

Programs

Hope Sisters: Breast cancer survivors deliver comfort, support, and bags of HOPE. **In 2024, 165 bags were delivered throughout the valley.**

Circle of Hope. Private Facebook group for questions, support, and new friendships.

Bingo For Boobies. Signature Fundraiser/Two events per year. **SPRING 2024, Funded 200 bags for future breast cancer warriors.**

Volunteers. Assemble bags, assist with events, and outreach programs. **2024**, **40 Active volunteers.**
